




The Villages Golf and Country Club, an active 55-plus community, is situated in the beautiful Evergreen foothills of San Jose, California.

The Villages is a private, secluded, gated community, which is part of the exciting San Francisco Bay Area, in the tenth largest city in the United States: San Jose—Capital of Silicon Valley. Established 49 years ago on the site of a former hillside vineyard and winery, the 2,309 condominiums and 227 single-family homes nestle into 1,200 acres of lush landscaping and sparkling lakes set against a picture-perfect background of natural beauty.

The focal point of The Villages is its spectacular championship golf course, Pro Shop, elegant Clubhouse and Restaurant, and Bistro & Bar. In addition to golf, there are four swimming pools and spas, six tennis courts and a new fitness center.

But the fun doesn't stop there. The Villages has something for every one of its roughly 4,000 residents. There are more than 100 social organizations, a full calendar of activities, fine arts,

personal gardening plots, stables, bocce courts and numerous facilities designed to encourage community life.

Near shopping, public transportation and the Bay Area's cultural community, The Villages has been rated among the top 20 senior communities (for persons aged 55 and older) in the United States by New Choices for Retirement Living Magazine.


In addition to the Pro Shop/Clubhouse complex with its full-service restaurant, lounge and banquet halls, there are four, fully equipped and furnished community centers ready to host just about any event. Controlled gate access and a 24/7 Public Safety presence provide Villages residents with the assurance of privacy.

Villages residents are active and engaged in their community, whether it be participating in community organizations, physical activities or cultural and artistic endeavors. Residents can stay in shape at their fitness center or by walking miles of pedestrian-friendly streets and well-marked hiking trails in the foothills, all within the property's

boundaries. And when it's time to relax, there's a well-stocked library with a nice selection of periodicals, videos and books. Residents can also stay in touch with the community's weekly newspaper, *The Villager*, and other electronic and televised media.

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



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Boards of Directors

The Villages Corporations

The three California corporations that are responsible for the governance of The Villages are listed below. All members belong to the Club corporation; members are then either a part of the Association or Homeowners' corporation.

The Villages Golf and Country Club ("The Country Club")

The Board of Directors of The Villages Golf and Country Club, a California corporation, is responsible for the management of Club operations. The Country Club is responsible for all recreational, social, and cultural events in operation at The Villages. The Country Club maintains streets, the community centers and adjoining swimming pools, the Clubhouse/Pro Shop complex, the two golf courses, tennis courts, and more. The Country Club manages, operates, and maintains these many facilities.

The Villages Homeowners' Corporation and The Villages Association have authorized The Villages Golf and Country Club to act as management agent for those two corporations.

The Villages Association ("The Association")

The Board of Directors of The Villages Association, a California corporation, is responsible for the management of the 2,309 condominiums and assocociated common areas. The Association is responsible for maintenance of the condominium common elements, such as exterior walls, roofs, and landscape. The Association carries property damage, earthquake and liability insurance for all buildings within the condominium area.

The Villages Homeowners ("Homeowners")

The Homeowners' Corporation consists of 227 single-family homes dispersed throughout The Villages. The 75 units collectively known as "The Estates" share some landscaping maintenance costs, and consequently have a different assessment basis compared to the other 152 homes.

The Board of Directors of The Villages Homeowners' Corporation, a California corporation, is responsible for governance of the single-family homes.

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

The Villages Golf and Country Club/Association Dues and Services

At The Villages, you are automatically a member of The Villages Golf and Country Club and either The Villages Association or The Homeowners' Corporation, when you purchase a condominium or single-family home. For one reasonable monthly fee (which includes both the Club and Association operating and reserve assessments), the Club and the Association provide a number of very important services you would pay for separately if you did not live at The Villages.

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Public Safety



The Villages Public Safety Department provides a wide variety of services on a 24-hour basis, with the goal of providing a safe and well-regulated community for all residents, guests and employees.

Residents will find a friendly and professional staff located in the Public Safety Plaza (at the entrance to The Villages). Uniformed Public Safety officers ensure that only those individuals who have been cleared as guests, or have official business in The Villages, are allowed entry. The Public Safety Department has a program to clear Villages' guests and contractors. Our improved system will be another effective measure in helping to keep The Villages more secure.





Public Safety's Administration Office is located in Building C near the tennis courts. Office hours are Monday through Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. and 1 p.m. to 4 p.m. The office number is 408-239-5246.

Public Safety officers routinely patrol The Villages and quickly assist residents in need. They regularly enforce traffic laws within The Villages. Officers are trained in CPR, first aid, and certified in the use of Automated External Defibrillators (A.E.D.s). For those accidentally locked out of their homes, Public Safety maintains a set of keys for condominiums. Public Safety officers can also assist residents with minor maintenance problems occurring after normal business hours.





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Cribari & Foothill Centers



Cribari Center

Located in Cribari Village on Cribari Lane, this is the keystone of the four community centers. The facility hosts a multi-use auditorium, fitness center, several meeting rooms, dedicated card rooms, a boutique featuring resident hand-crafted items for sale, a post office, a community library, guest rooms, a woodshop, arts and crafts room, billiards, a ceramics room, and Wi-Fi service.








Foothill Center

Foothill Center is located at the intersections of Fairway Drive, Village View Drive and Olive Grove Way. The facility hosts a pool, spa and social hall with kitchen. The social hall accommodates up to 100 people for dining, or up to 125 people for meetings. There is a barbecue area near the main entrance to the facility. The social hall is equipped with a public address system, projection screen, and Wi-Fi service.





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Vineyard and Montgomery Centers



Vineyard Center is located at the intersection of Villages Parkway and Fairway Drive. The facility hosts a pool, spa and social hall with kitchen. The social hall accommodates up to 70 people and is equipped with a public address system, projection screen, and Wi-Fi service.

Montgomery Center is located in Montgomery Village off Montgomery Lane and Wehner Way. The facility hosts a pool, spa, multi-purpose room, and social hall with kitchen. Adjacent to the kitchen is an outdoor barbecue area. The social hall accommodates up to 50 people. Wi-Fi service is also available.

Facilities & Amenities



The Fitness Center

The Fitness Center is open from 5 a.m. to 10 p.m. daily, but is closed for cleaning between noon and 1 p.m. Only personal trainers contracted through The Villages are permitted to provide training services in the facility. It is strongly suggested that residents consult their physicians prior to engaging in any type of exercise.

Residents must attend a one-hour class prior to using the Fitness Center. Register in the Community Activities office. After completion of the class, return the certification form to Community Activities and sign a liability release.

Pools and Spas

Cribari Pool and Spa: The heated pool and spa are open for use April 1 through October 31. The swimming pool and spa are available 5 a.m. to 10 p.m. Children's swim hours are from 10 a.m. to noon.

Montgomery Pool and Spa: The heated pool and spa are open April 1 through October 31. The swimming pool and spa are available 5 a.m. to 10 p.m. Children's swim hours are from noon to 2 p.m.

Vineyard Pool and Spa: The heated pool and spa are traditionally open year round, 5 a.m. to 10 p.m. Children's swim hours are from 2 p.m. to 4 p.m.

Foothill Pool and Spa: The heated pool and spa are open for use April 1 through October 31. The swimming pool and spa are available 5 a.m. to 10 p.m. This is an adults-only pool.

The Villages Hiking Trails

There are more than 500 acres of open space, which include seven hiking trails offering recreational opportunities ranging from easy to challenging experiences. Trails offer hikers vistas overlooking Santa Clara Valley, wildlife and beautiful scenery.





Facilities & Amenities



Gazebo Park

Available for use by residents and their guests, Gazebo Park is a picnic and barbecue facility. It features mature shade trees, electricity and running water. There are picnic tables to accommodate up to 150 people and two large charcoal barbecue pits. A small group of four tables and two small charcoal barbecue pits are available without reservations (adjacent to the bocce courts).



The Villages GCC Library

The Villages Library is a volunteerrun, community-based library. It is open seven days a week, Monday to Saturday, 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. and Sunday 2 to 5 p.m. The library has hard-back, paper-back, and large-print books. The library also has books on tapes, CDs, and a limited number of movies. The library has reference books, daily papers and periodicals. A community computer is available for residents to use. Complimentary wireless internet access is available, as well as at several community centers.

RV Storage

The Villages offers fee-based, onsite storage for resident-owned and registered recreational vehicles, boats and trailers. The storage lot has a dump station and a limited number of electrical outlets.



The Villages Stables

Residents may board horses at the community stables for a rental fee. Stable facilities include a barn, paddocks and exercise area. There are also seven bridle paths available in the hill lands.



Community Garden Plots

For those who find gardening relaxing as well as productive in providing fresh vegetables for the table, The Villages provides two separate gardens. The first and oldest has 60 individual garden plots and the second has 37 garden plots. These are located in between the Stables and Foothill Center and at the top of Village View Drive.

Tennis

The Villages has six USTA regulation tennis courts. They are available for use by Villages' residents and their guests. The Tennis Club offers opportunities for recreational and tournament play. No matter your skill level, there is an opportunity for you to enjoy The Villages' tennis courts.

Two bocce courts are available for residents and their guests by reservation. Courts are located adjacent to Gazebo Park's picnic area. There are Bocce Bashes most Fridays throughout the year, and with Gazebo Park nearby, you can have a great time with your family at Gazebo Park and the bocce courts.

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The Villages Golf & Country Club was founded in 1967. The 18-Hole Championship Course was designed by famous golf course architect Robert Muir Graves. The Villages golf course features wide, inviting fairways and receptive greens. Mature pine and eucalyptus trees line the fairways. The greens challenge all golfers to conquer the supple slopes.

Enjoy the beauty of the eight lakes as you play your way through 135 manicured acres. All 18 holes are equipped with four sets of tees to accommodate golfers of all skill levels.

Villages Country Club members can play 18 holes of golf for \$29 with no additional membership fees.

The Par 3 course is placed within the confines of the front nine of the 18-Hole Championship Course and offers a unique golfing experience for novice and experienced golfers alike. It is an ideal place for new golfers learning the game or for experienced golfers honing their skills.



In addition to the golf course, there are great practice facilities, including a 15-stall driving range and two shortgame practice areas to perfect your wedge and bunker play. And the 8,000 square-foot practice putting green is the perfect place to work on your putting skills.

Catering to your golfing needs, the Pro Shop offers friendly service, easy check-in and a wide range of golf apparel, equipment and merchandise to take your game to the next level.




